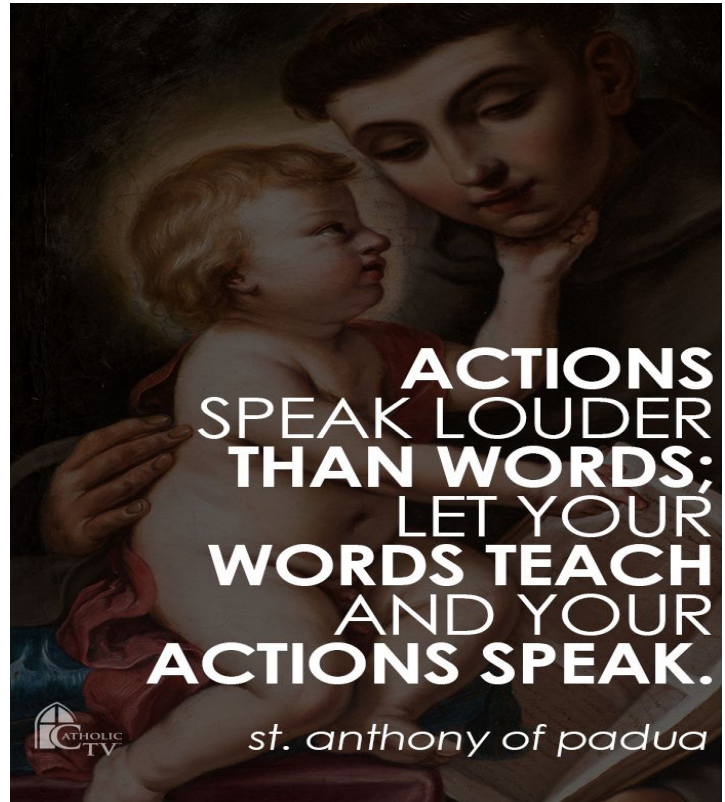

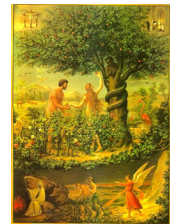


WEEKLY READINGS:

FIRST READING: GENESIS 3:9-15

A reading from the Book of Genesis

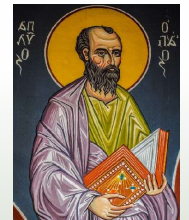
